Mary Eichhorn, Choir Director and Organist at St. Andrew's Methodist Church, Spring Lake, has generously donated two baritones, a flute, a trumpet, two snare drums, a practice pad, and instruction books for the thousand children in the Ugandan village of Masaka and their teachers who wish to make their lives brighter with music. The project is under the guidance of Sylvia's Children, Holmdel, a 501c3 charity that has built a school, a dormitory, a well, and a library, and has delivered medical and school supplies. Three hundred of the one thousand students are AIDS orphans who board at the school. Sylvia Allen, founder of this charity, personally takes the donations with her on her flights to Uganda three times a year. This project will be on-going and any assistance you or your colleagues can give to support this drive for used but playable musical instruments would be greatly appreciated.
