This was the scripture quoted on the bulletin cover for the moving and deeply spiritual memorial service celebrating the life of Robert G. Spencer held at the United Methodist Church, Red Bank on January 19th, 2008. Bob died on January 7th after a long and difficult struggle with Alzheimer's disease. His friends, family and musical associates honored him with hymns, words, solos, and special choral selections sung by a massed choir from his church, the Shrewsbury Chorale, Monmouth Civic Chorus, and the community.
