George served as organist and choir director at various churches in the area for over sixty-seven years. He was a music teacher in the Belmar School, a private piano teacher and was the organist/choir director at West Grove United Methodist Church in Neptune up until the night he was hospitalized. He received diplomas from the Guilmont Organ School, attended the Juilliard School, Monmouth College, and Temple University. He was eighty-four years old.

Peg served as church organist and music director for the First Presbyterian Church, Freehold for more than thirty years and also played the organ at several other churches in Freehold. She was a graduate of Westminster Choir College and was ninety years old when she died.
